*To the Faculty, Staff, Students & Parents of CSCA,*

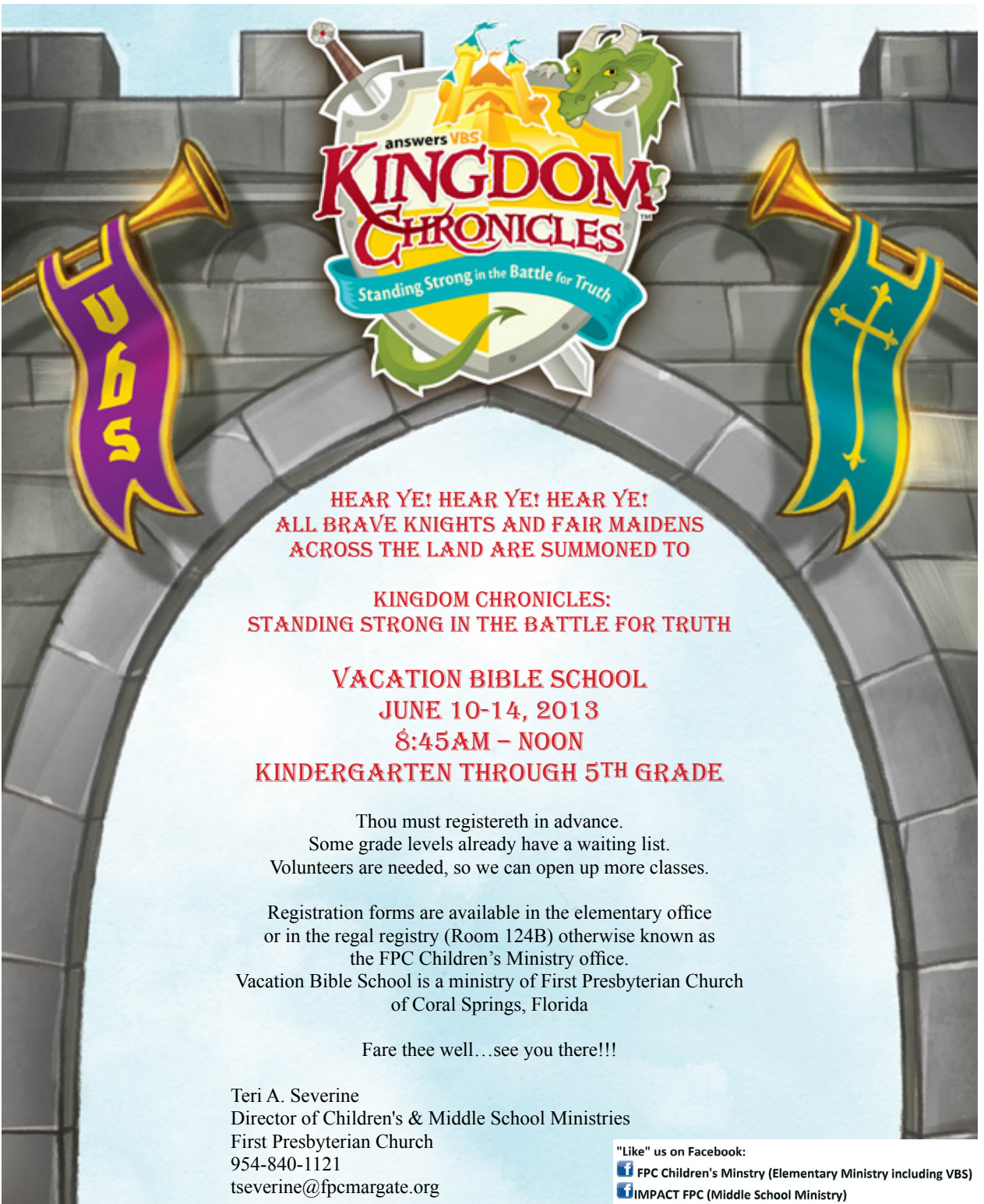

## **Mr. Austin Drew Cantrell - President of the Senior Class of 2013** **Senior Chapel Address on May 9, 2013**

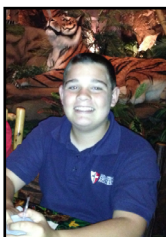

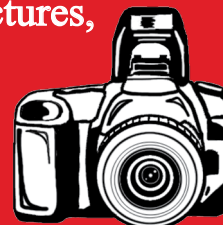

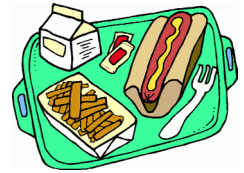
