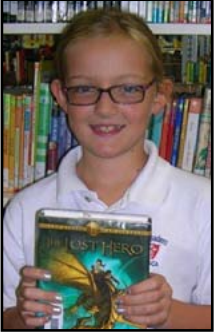
Congratulations Alexandra!
