Veterans' Day is a national holiday honoring the veterans of all of America's wars. Veterans' Day is celebrated on November 11th each year and recalls the sacrifices of war and contributions to peace of our veterans. Armistice Day is the original name of this holiday because it commemorated the armistice that ended the fighting between Germany and the Allied powers in World War I. The end of World War I was ended at 11 a.m. on November 11, 1918.

A parade was held in Birmingham, Alabama to honor all American veterans at the end of World War II in 1947. Sometime after a bill was passed to change the name Armistice Day to Veteran's Day. President Dwight D. Eisenhower signed the bill into law in 1954.

All 50 states and the U.S. territories and possessions observe Veterans' Day. The national observance takes place at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier at Arlington National Cemetery in Arlington, Virginia. This tomb contains the remains of soldiers from WWI, WWII, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War. This is a solemn service beginning at 11 a.m. with our U.S. President laying a wreath at the tomb. "Taps" are played by a bugler and veterans groups take part in a "Parade of Flags". Throughout the United States, cities and towns hold parades, flag ceremonies, and celebrations that honor our military.

Veterans' Day honors all of our veterans—the living and those that have died. Memorial Day, celebrated the last Monday in May, honors military personnel who have died in our American Wars.
